

Student Internet User Agreement

I agree to follow the online rules set out below when I use the internet or a log-on account:

Communicating with Clarity and Precision while Taking Responsible Risks

- I will ask the teacher first before using digital technologies at school.
- I will ask the teacher before opening and saving work to my thumb drive.
- I will not let other people log-on to my account without checking with the teacher first.
- I will tell the teacher if I see anything that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- I will tell the teacher if I think someone is using my log-on account.
- I will only use work from the Internet if I have asked the teacher.



Managing Impulsivity

- I will not give my password out to others.
- I will not give out my name, phone number, address, name of the school, photographs or other details about myself or others without checking with the teacher first.
- I will only use my thumb drive to open and save work unless instructed otherwise by the teacher.
- I will only use my user name and password when logging on to a computer unless instructed otherwise by the teacher.
- I will take care when using the computer equipment and will not change the computer settings.
- I will not use the computers to be mean, rude or unkind about other people.



Thinking about your Thinking

- If I download work or pictures from the Internet I will say where it comes from.
- I know that I am responsible for anything that happens when my online services account is used.
- I know that the school and the Department of Education and Training may see anything I send or receive using the email service.
- I know that I am responsible for what is saved on my thumb drive.



I understand that:

- That the misuse of online services may result in the withdrawal of access to services and other consequences in accordance with the Churchlands Primary School Behavioural Management Policy.

I agree to abide by the acceptable usage agreement for school students. I understand that if I am given an online service account and break any of the rules in the agreement; it may result in disciplinary action, determined by the school administration in accordance with the Department's Behaviour Management in Schools policy.
